- Minutes from December 7, 2017 unanimously approved
- Adult & Teen Services Librarian's Report:
 - New Hires, Wendy West & Renan Ferreira, offer promising skill sets by way of STEM and graphic design backgrounds.
 - A yearlong subscription to Adobe's Creative Cloud has been purchased
 - Booktalk podcast in the works
 - Programming: Lunch at the Library, Framed Flowers, Card Making, Oil & Vinegar tastings, upcoming Knitting Nights
 - o 3D printers require maintenance, will have an update to report in February
 - Goals: open Maker-Space for public use during limited hours, obtain software maintenance from MIS for public computers
 - Some PCs running on Windows XP which is no longer supported by Microsoft
 - Computer lab now staffed by a volunteer from Kaplan
 - Community Hub: partnership with Community Concepts to connect people in need with local outfits that offer help. Building monitors can direct patrons to the hub
 - o Problems:
 - Off-desk time is tight (program planning, collection development, website maintenance). Currently 30 out of 37.5 hours go to desk time.
 - Orientation of service desk on 2nd floor is difficult to locate. Signage and a standing workstation for a part-timer would address this.
 - Chair shortage on 2nd floor there are 45 chairs for 64 corrals.
